### Psalm 47 (ESV)

God Is King over All the Earth  
To the choirmaster. A Psalm of the Sons of Korah.

*Clap your hands, all peoples!  
Shout to God with loud songs of joy!*  
<sup>2</sup> *For the LORD, the Most High, is to be feared,  
a great king over all the earth.*  
<sup>3</sup> *He subdued peoples under us,  
and nations under our feet.*  
<sup>4</sup> *He chose our heritage for us,  
the pride of Jacob whom he loves. Selah*  
<sup>5</sup> *God has gone up with a shout,  
the LORD with the sound of a trumpet.*  
<sup>6</sup> *Sing praises to God, sing praises!  
Sing praises to our King, sing praises!*  
<sup>7</sup> *For God is the King of all the earth;  
sing praises with a psalm!*  
<sup>8</sup> *God reigns over the nations;  
God sits on his holy throne.*  
<sup>9</sup> *The princes of the peoples gather  
as the people of the God of Abraham.  
For the shields of the earth belong to God;  
he is highly exalted!*
